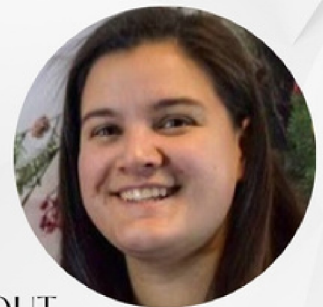
## JOSH & COURTNEY WILTROUT

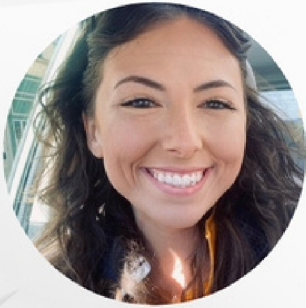


LORI PERRY

March 2023

*God has united you with Christ Jesus. For our benefit God made him to be wisdom itself. Christ made us right with God; he made us pure and holy, and he freed us from sin. Therefore, as the Scriptures say, "If you want to boast, boast only about the Lord." - 1 Cor. 1: 30-31 (NLT)*

I recently attended a concert of one of my favorite bands. When we know that they are going to be near us we try to see them. I have to be honest, it isn't just their music. They are one of the few groups that take time to clearly present the gospel. They have a new album called *Whosoever*. On that album is one of my newest favorites, "Boast In The Cross."

Easter is coming and much of what God's church is focusing on is the cross. The cross to me represents the proof of God's love: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. This is the perfect opportunity for us to boast in the cross. God loves people so much that "He sent His One and Only Son, that whosoever believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life." It's not because we are special or better than anyone. It's because of God's love and what he has made available to everyone. It's because of who God is and what He has done to make forgiveness and eternal life possible.

The song points out that we ourselves have nothing to brag about. We fall short in everything that we have done, but God still loves His children. And the power of the cross still stands. To the songwriter, the cross represents the gospel, revival, the Savior, and His power. And he is not ashamed. To Paul, it was the One who was crucified on the cross, buried and raised again, who "made us right with God; He made us pure and holy and He freed us from sin." It's our weakness that shows how powerful the cross really is.

So as your Pastor, please let me encourage you to spend more time focusing on and boasting about what God has done on the cross. Think of the sacrifice that God made when He sent His Son to die for the sins of people. Think about what He has brought you through, is carrying you through, and has prepared for you. Spend these days—and all your days—boasting in the cross, boasting in the Lord. Let's bring glory to God!
