Tim Florian officially joins Young Life on June 1, 2024, as the new Area Director for Fayette County. He has already begun meeting with our Committee, representing Young Life at local youth events, and preparing for a Young Life co-sponsored Baccalaureate Christian service for graduating seniors from the Uniontown area high schools (to be held on May 19th at 3:30 PM at Grace Brethren Church).

For the past two and one-half years, Tim served as an Area Representative for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) in southwestern PA, focusing primarily on Westmoreland and Fayette Counties. Tim supported or led multiple high school FCA clubs (Franklin Regional, Hempfield Area, Kiski Area, Plum Borough, Apollo-Ridge, Albert Gallatin, Laurel Highlands, Uniontown, Chestnut Ridge Christian Academy, Yough, Greensburg Salem, Derry Area, Greater Latrobe, and Fort Cherry). Prior to serving as a full-time missionary for FCA, Tim volunteered for thirteen years as an FCA board member, camp coach, and character coach.

Tim is currently a character coach for Franklin Regional High School Wrestling in Murrysville, Laurel Highlands High School Football in Uniontown, and the Connellsville Youth Wrestling program. He will remain as an Ambassador to FCA, bringing many sports connections to his Young Life position.

Tim grew up in Ohio and attended the U.S. Naval Academy, where he earned a B.S. in Math and was commissioned in the Marine Corps. He served ten and one-half years as a Marine Supply Officer, and then more than twenty years as a federal employee. Tim and his wife, Cindy, live in Uniontown. Their son, Troy, attends Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and daughter, Rachel, lives in Maryland.

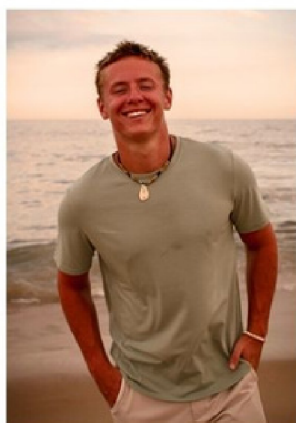

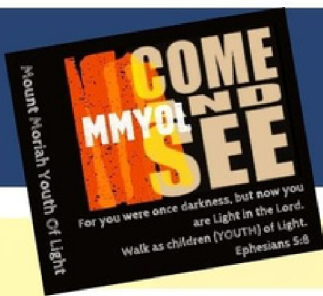
