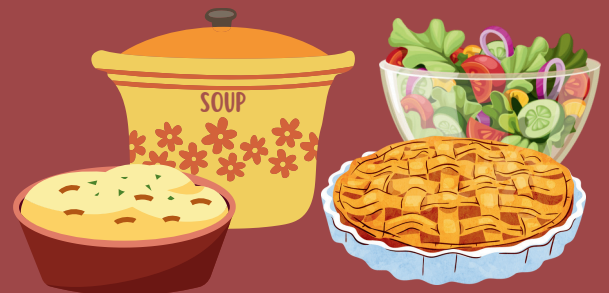

COME AND SEE!

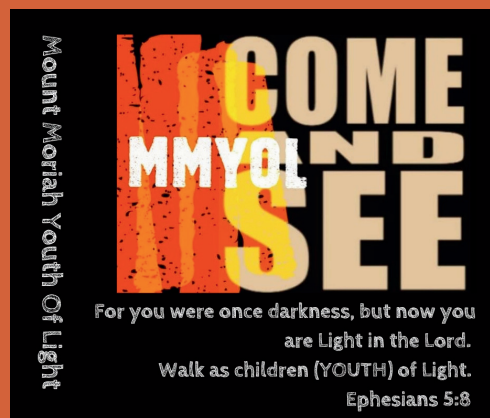

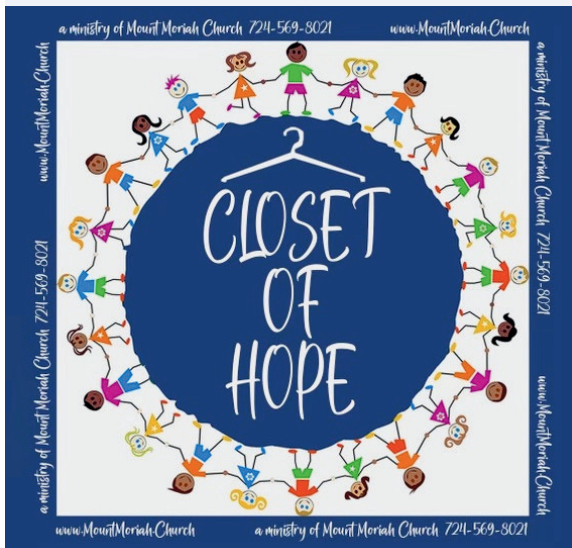

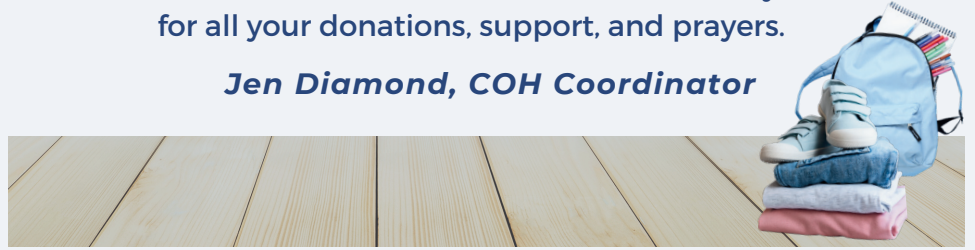




All praise to God for a successful **BACK TO SCHOOL EVENT!**

I love it when I come across scriptures that I feel mention me specifically. John 20:29 is one of those verses. Jesus has just shown Thomas, His physically resurrected self. And then Jesus says something remarkable, “Because you have seen me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe.” There I am, “Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe.”

I have never physically encountered the resurrected Jesus like the disciples and more than five hundred others between the resurrection and ascension of Jesus did. Jesus has revealed himself to me by His Spirit and by His Word, and there is enough evidence for me to believe, but I have never “seen” Him. Jesus in this passage mentions me and many others who will believe in Him based solely on hearing the good news and the evidence of its validity, and He declares a special blessing to me and all of those who believe like me.

I pray that you see yourself in the Scriptures. Dig deep and pay close attention. God’s Word sometimes speaks to us specifically and directly. It can provide for you peace, comfort, wisdom, strength, and sometimes a special blessing. May it help you to love God more and love others better.
