

On Sunday, February 13th, the ONLINE ministry celebrated its 100th broadcast of Sunday Service LIVE! We are very grateful for our talented and dedicated volunteers who help us reach people for Jesus and provide an opportunity for those participating to connect and stay connected to the family of God.

Todd Hillman

Todd became familiar with Mount Moriah Church about 15 years ago while producing the Mount Moriah Baptist Church Sunday services on TV for the Herald Standard TV station in Uniontown. He started attending Mount Moriah and began recording and producing DVDs for anyone that wanted a recording of the Sunday service. When the COVID pandemic hit in 2020, Todd's technical skills in video engineering and videography, such as filming, using streaming computers, multiple cameras, remote and lighting controllers, video and audio switchers, and installing cameras, were critical in transitioning Mount Moriah to producing Sunday morning livestream services, *PRAISEbreaks*, and other ONLINE events.

Almost every Sunday morning for the past seven years, Lisa has been in the production booth generating and displaying announcements, songs, scriptures, and pictures on the screen at the front of the church so that those attending as well as our ONLINE viewers are able to participate in the worship service.



George Paschke

George manages the Information Technology (IT) infrastructure and is responsible for setting up and maintaining the internet circuits and connections, computer systems, printers, and email accounts for the church and school.



Josh and Courtney Wiltrout

Josh and Courtney have been responsible for engineering and installing all of the new sound systems and lighting in the sanctuary. Josh installed the lighting (with Courtney's help) while Courtney built all the lighting schemes on the computer software system to manage the lights. They also engineered and added new sound equipment and programmed the soundboard for different occasions. The soundboard system provides the sound for both in-person services and the ONLINE livestream broadcasts, PRAISEbreaks, and special events. They assist with recordings and sound production by setting up and testing sound and recording equipment, sound mixing, and editing recordings. Courtney also serves as a backup ONLINE Hostess for Sunday morning services.

Shawn is a trainee for the ONLINE production position and is a backup for Todd in producing the Sunday morning livestream services.




Chris King

GENERAL FUND

Greetings My Brothers and Sisters,

Have I ever introduced you to or invited you to try Appalachian Brewing Company root beer, Jackson Farm's chocolate milk, or Harry's bacon? These are three things that have changed my life. Have I ever told you about a new or favorite restaurant of mine? Have I ever talked to you about my children? I am like most of you.
