During the first five months of 2021, we reached (in one way or another) over 18,000 individuals. Mount Moriah videos and media posts are viewed thousands of times every month, granting us an opportunity to reach more people for Jesus than we ever imagined!

The mission of the ONLINE Ministry, briefly stated, is the same as every other ministry of the church, "Love God, love people and make disciples." Which means we use social media more like a pulpit and less like a bulletin. Yes, at times we do advertise events taking place at the church, but the vast majority of our posts and videos teach, preach, praise, and are all about Jesus.

Looking forward, we will continue to broadcast Sunday Worship, "Pastor D LIVE", *PRAISEbreaks*, a few special events, and post our almost daily scripture verses. Additionally, we're hoping to re-launch a once monthly version of *KIDS' Church* and initiate a new program or two.
